Nasser Al-Hairi Corporation was awarded the contract for the Off plot and Jetties in the 3rd Quarter of 2007, which was the last major Contract to be awarded on the Pearl GTL Project, Nasser Al-Hajri Corporation's immediate challenge was to achieve HSSE readiness to start to allow them to commence with construction. Build Relationships

Talk about safety, incidents, injuries, successes and Incident and Injury-Free performance by speaking with people about people, not numbers and programmes. Make it truly safe for people to express their doubts and differing opinions.

Make it truly safe for people to express their concerns about fair treatment, quality-of-life at work and any dignity and respect issues.

Set the "relationship standard" by being seen and heard listening and speaking to people in their work place (e.g. in the field). Make sure you are constantly working to improve the quality of your relationships.

PROMOTE AND RENEW POSSIBILITY

Speak often to people about safety. Rather than slip into a standard speech when talking about safety, speak about why it matters to you personally and your personal vision for safety. Respond to everything that "goes wrong" regarding safety with a "What can we learn?" approach. Talk about the breakthrough that could come from the lessons learned from the breakdown; make the conversation real, open and include all views and perspectives.

Allow people to express their doubts, concerns and issues; the freedom to express them is the only pathway to creating the possibility of Incident and Injury Free.

Demonstrate your commitment to being Incident and Injury-Free by staying open minded, flexible and allowing others to suggest different ways of accomplishing it.



Find or Create Opportunity

Describe incident and Injury-Free in a way that makes it seem not only possible, but also feasible; use clear examples of how people can participate in being Incident and Injury Free

Create vivid pictures for others of what being Incident and Injury Free looks-like.

Create opportunities to send loud and clear messages that enforce the commitment to working Incident and Injury Free.
Frequently ask "Where will our next injury happen?" and then ask "What are we going to do to prevent it?

Take action and Inspire others to act

Take action that demonstrate your commitment to an Incident and Injury Free environment; inspire others to do the same. Through your own actions, model the values and priorities you endorse.

Make bold promises and unreasonable requests.
Work with others to produce more and more communication and coordination of safety efforts. Surface potential obstacles, concerns, doubts or breakdowns by demonstrating, with your questions and responses, that it is safe to raise issues and that you will respond or act thoughtfully and decisively.

Hold yourself and others to account for following up on safety commitments. Manage and follow up on the completion of safety releated tasks or r equests. Make it clear that everyone should stop a job they view as dangerous.

MANAGE COMPLETION

Throughout the journey, ensure that everything and everyone is complete at each step and ready for the next.

Be seen and heard expressing your appreciation and regard for accomplishment in safety, especially in places you are not normally seen or heard.

Turn results into accomplishments by making it clear how they support and make possible an Incident and Injury Free workplace.

Look for new ways to highlight positive safety performance.
